Working Conditions:

- Different locations every semester/summer week.

- Occasionally required to climb or balance; and stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl.
- Ability to lift and/or move up to 35 pounds.
- Own transportation to fit 14 Lego sets and teacher class material. Fall and Spring semesters only.
- Safe and clean area at home to storage material after each class.
- Use of computing equipment like tablets/IPads, projector and laptops.
- Work evenings and weekends as needed (Private events only).

Job Description

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Establish and enforce rules for behavior and procedures for maintaining order among the students for whom they are responsible.
- Adapt teaching/building methods and instructional materials to meet students' varying needs and interests. Always staying under the company guidelines.
- Instruct students individually and/or groups according to needs.
- Prepare materials for your class activities, this includes organizing LEGO material before and after each class.
- Establish clear objectives for every lesson and projects, and communicate those objectives to students.
- Plan and conduct activities for a balanced program of instruction, demonstration, and work time that provides students with opportunities to observe, question, investigate, and play.

- Use the equipment and materials to supplement your presentations. Let administration know if you need anything to make your class more fun.
- Instruct and monitor students in the use and care of equipment and materials to prevent injuries and damage.
- Attend professional meetings and teacher training workshops.
- Select, store, order, issue, sanitize, and inventory classroom equipment, materials, and supplies at the end of semester/summer camp week.

- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Knowledge of positive teaching techniques.
- Must be flexible and adaptable to meet the needs of the families enrolled in the program.

- Must be able to work in the evening and on weekends, if necessary.
- Ability to control and help students under stress.
